While COVID-19 impacted 2020 in many wide and varied ways, it didn't stop us from pushing forward with one of our most important whole school projects to date.

With the guidance and support of our Aboriginal Community Education Officer Philippa Tierney, the Indigenous students at Magill School began a project to create a Magill School Acknowledgement to Country to strengthen



our whole school understanding and recognition of the First Nations' People and the connection to Kaurna Land which our school stands on today.

Our Year 7 students Kase and Kobe researched the history behind why we acknowledge Kaurna Land and then worked together to write a Magill School Acknowledgement to Country. This Acknowledgement was then translated and provided Kaurna Warra Karrpanthi.

The accompanying piece of artwork to this project provided each of our Indigenous students with an opportunity to express their connection to our school through the use of specific Aboriginal symbols within a section of the combined artwork. The students then worked with Jordan Lovegrove from Karko Creations to turn their artwork into the beautiful image we have today. The students were involved in the design process the whole way through, and the integrity of their design and symbols chosen was kept. Only when the students involved were happy with the completed design was the image finalized for use.

With the support of one of our very talented teacher Mike Shortt, we then recorded the Acknowledgement to Country as a video which we will then be able to use at whole school events.

On Wednesday 26th May 2021, as a precursor to National Reconciliation Week 2021, our Indigenous students launched the Acknowledgment to Country words and video with our school community by presenting their yearlong project. While speaking to large groups of students is daunting for many, the students involved presented confidently and clearly, and demonstrated their passion and understanding of the project for all to witness.

As a school we are so incredibly proud of the work our Indigenous students have done to bring the words of this Acknowledgement to Country to life through the deep and meaningful personalisation

and recognition of the acknowledgement.


P13 and F11 worked together to create artwork for Reconciliation Week. We talked about what reconciliation means and how we move forward together and make positive steps towards reconciliation.
