

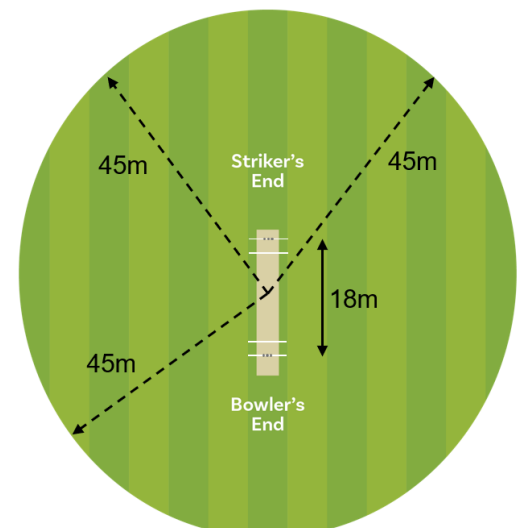
ADELAIDE STRIKERS PRIMARY SCHOOL CRICKET

YEAR 5/6: ONE-PAGE RULESHEET

OVERS	20 OVERS PER INNINGS
BALL	142G KOOKABURRA PRACTICE RED BALL
TIME	3 HOURS (ALL OVERS BOWLED FROM THE SAME END TO REDUCE TIME)
BOUNDARY	45-METRE BOUNDARY MEASURED FROM STRIKER'S END STUMPS, MARKED WITH CONES
PITCH LENGTH	18 METRE PITCH, STUMP TO STUMP – HARD WICKET OR TURF.
PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT	ALL BATTERS AND WICKET KEEPERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A BRITISH STANDARD 7928:2013 COMPLIANT HELMET AT ALL TIMES. PADS AND GLOVES ARE ALSO REQUIRED.
TEAM NUMBERS	9 PLAYERS PER TEAM. A MINIMUM OF 7 PLAYERS, MAXIMUM OF 11 PLAYERS
DISMISSALS	ALL MODES OF DISMISSAL COUNT. UMPIRES ENCOURAGED TO BE LENIENT WITH LBW CALLS
BATTING	USING THE BELOW TABLE, BATTERS RETIRE ONCE REACHING THEIR FULL ALLOTMENT OF BALLS. ALL DELIVERIES FACED, INCLUDING WIDES AND NO-BALLS ARE INCLUDED IN THE BALL COUNT. BATTERS ARE TO RETIRE AS SOON AS THEY HAVE FACED THEIR ALLOTMENT OF BALLS, NOT AT THE END OF THE OVER. THE BATTER ON STRIKE SHALL FACE THE LAST 'EXTRA' BALL OF THE INNINGS, SHOULD THIS BE NEEDED.
BOWLING	ALL PLAYERS TO BOWL. BOWLERS TO BOWL FROM ONE END. MAXIMUM OF 6 BALLS IN AN OVER (WIDES AND NO-BALLS ARE NOT RE-BOWLED).
WIDES	ANY BALL PASSING OUTSIDE THE REACH OF A BATTER IN THEIR NORMAL STANCE THAT DOES NOT BOUNCE OFF THE PITCH. WIDES WILL INCUR A ONE RUN PENALTY
NO BALLS	A NO-BALL WILL INCUR A 1-RUN PENALTY PLUS ANY EXTRA RUNS MADE BY THE BATTERS (I.E. BYES, RUNS OFF THE BAT, ETC.) A NO-BALL IS EITHER: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A FULL TOSS ABOVE WAIST HEIGHT OF THE BATTER IN A STANDING POSITION - ABOVE SHOULDER HEIGHT OF THE BATTER, IN AN UPRIGHT STANDING POSITION FROM A SHORT-PITCHED BALL - A BALL THAT BOUNCES MORE THAN ONCE OR ROLLS ALONG THE GROUND BEFORE IT REACHES THE POPPING CREASE - ANY BALL THAT LANDS OR BOUNCES OFF THE PITCH - A BALL WHERE THE HEEL OF THE BOWLER'S FRONT FOOT LANDS ON, OR INFRONT OF THE POPPING CREASE (BOWLERS ARE TO RECEIVE A WARNING FROM THE OFFICIATING UMPIRE PRIOR TO BEING CALLED FOR A FRONT FOOT NO-BALL)
DEAD BALL	ANY BALL THAT DEVIATES FROM THE EDGE OF THE WICKET MATTING, CONCRETE, OR RAISED PIECE OF TURF. DEAD BALLS ARE RE-BOWLED.
FIELDING	NO MORE THAN 9 PLAYERS ON THE FIELD AT A TIME. NO FIELDERS TO BE WITHIN 10 METRES OF BATTER WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE WICKETKEEPER.

8 PLAYERS	20 BALLS	4 X 3 OVERS, 4 X 2 OVERS
9 PLAYERS	20 BALLS	4 X 3 OVERS, 3 X 2 OVERS 2 X 1 OVER
10 PLAYERS	15 BALLS	2 X 3 OVERS, 6 X 2 OVERS 2 X 1 OVER
11 PLAYERS	15 BALLS	1 X 3 OVERS, 7 X 2 OVERS 3 X 1 OVER

WEATHER POLICY

HOT WEATHER - CANCELLATION IN ADVANCE

LOCATIONS FOR TEMPERATURE READINGS ARE AS FOLLOWS;
ADELAIDE STRIKERS PRIMARY SCHOOL CRICKET – ADELAIDE

THURSDAY AFTERNOON MATCHES

THE FINAL DECISION ON WHETHER THURSDAY AFTERNOON MATCHES ARE PLAYED WILL BE MADE FOLLOWING THE UPDATED BOM FORECAST RELEASED ON WEDNESDAY AT 12:00PM. SHOULD THE FORECAST TEMPERATURE FOR 5:30PM THURSDAY ON THE BOM APP, AS AT 12:00PM ON WEDNESDAY EVENING BE 36 DEGREES CELSIUS OR ABOVE, ALL MATCHES WILL BE CANCELLED.

FRIDAY AFTERNOON MATCHES

THE FINAL DECISION ON WHETHER FRIDAY AFTERNOON MATCHES ARE PLAYED WILL BE MADE FOLLOWING THE UPDATED BOM FORECAST RELEASED ON THURSDAY AT 12:00PM. SHOULD THE FORECAST TEMPERATURE FOR 5:30PM FRIDAY ON THE BOM APP, AS AT 12:00PM ON THURSDAY EVENING BE 36 DEGREES CELSIUS OR ABOVE, ALL MATCHES WILL BE CANCELLED.

SATURDAY MORNING MATCHES

THE FINAL DECISION ON WHETHER SATURDAY MORNING MATCHES ARE PLAYED WILL BE MADE FOLLOWING THE UPDATED BOM FORECAST RELEASED ON FRIDAY AT 12:00PM. SHOULD THE FORECAST TEMPERATURE FOR 12:30PM ON SATURDAY ON THE BOM APP, AS AT 12:00PM ON FRIDAY BE 36 DEGREES CELSIUS OR ABOVE, ALL MATCHES WILL BE CANCELLED.

IF THE FORECAST FALLS BELOW THE THRESHOLD TO CANCEL MATCHES;

IN ALL REMAINING SITUATIONS, PLAY WILL OCCUR AND SHALL CONTINUE UNTIL THE WEATHER REACHES 36 DEGREES AT THE VENUE OF THE MATCH ON THURSDAY, FRIDAY OR SATURDAY (AS PER THE BOM APP). SHOULD THE TEMPERATURE THRESHOLD BE REACHED DURING THE DAY AND PLAY BE CANCELLED, THAT SHALL BE THE FINAL OUTCOME FOR THE DAY AND PLAY SHALL NOT RESUME.

WE UNDERSTAND THAT EACH SCHOOL HAS THEIR OWN HEAT POLICY, IF YOUR SCHOOL POLICY IS BELOW OUR THRESHOLD (36 DEGREES CELSIUS) THEN IT WILL BE UP TO SCHOOL TO CONTACT THE TEAM THEY ARE SCHEDULED TO PLAY TO NOTIFY THEM OF THE ABANDONMENT OF THE MATCH.

WET WEATHER

NOTE: IN THE EVENT THAT A HOME SCHOOL NOTIFIES THE OPPOSITION THAT THE GROUND IS UNSUITABLE FOR PLAY, A **HOME SCHOOL OFFICIAL** MUST ALSO NOTIFY THE SACA COMPETITION ADMINISTRATOR(S) VIA EMAIL AT COMPETITIONS@SACA.COM.AU BY **6:00PM ON THE DAY PRIOR TO THE MATCH.**

WHERE NO CANCELLATION HAS OCCURRED BY 6:00PM ON THE DAY PRIOR TO THE MATCH, BOTH TEAMS AND PLAYERS MUST ATTEND THE GROUND READY FOR THE MATCH TO BEGIN AS SCHEDULED, UNLESS THE SCHOOL COORDINATORS OR COACHES HAVE MADE CONTACT WITH EACH OTHER THROUGHOUT THE DAY TO CANCEL THE MATCH.
