

Head Lice Policy

These procedures have been developed in line with current DECD guidelines.

GI

If a case of head lice is suspected:

- The teacher will notify the office •
- The office will contact the parent / emergency contact person to arrange for the child to be checked and treated as soon as possible.
- Parents are not required to collect their children if they are infested with (suspected) live lice before the end of the school day.
- The child should not be isolated but be able to participate in the class activities. It is • advised that these children are not involved in activities that include hair to hair / head to head contact.
- It is desirable to meet the parent / guardian when they pick the child up to offer advice and explain the requirement to treat the child before he / she returns to school.
- Parents of the other children in the class will be notified by the school that there is a suspected case(s) of head lice by giving each child in the class the school a head lice notification note.

Mass head lice checks are not carried out at Magill School.
