Knowledge and Experience:

- Effective consultative, interpersonal and supervisory skills
- Experience interacting with groups of children from 5 – 12 years of age
- Ability to interact with children in a positive, sensitive and respectful manner
- Ability to plan, develop, implement and evaluate developmentally appropriate programs
- Adequate cleaning and food handling skills.

Must have qualifications prior to application:

- Current DCSI Screening
- Current Responding to Abuse and Neglect training (RAN-EC full 7 hour)
- Current HLTAID004 Provide First Aid

Qualified Applicants must hold a qualification approved by ACECQA.

Which can be Diploma in Children's Services, completed two years of university (*teaching*) or equivalent.

Please include in your application:

- Cover letter outlining why you believe you're a suitable applicant.
- Your resume including relevant qualifications and attach certificates
- Weekday availability with times. (e.g. 7:00am – 11:00am, 2:00 – 6:15pm)
- Relevant Experience (OSHC Desired)
- 3 professional referees and contact details
