- Reinforcing musical concepts: beat, rhythm, and pitch
- Experimenting with tempo (fast and slow) in songs and music playing.

Year 2 to Year 6 Music

- Practising in tune singing and playing musical games
- Playing on the beat and developing an understanding of rhythm
- Recalling, reinforcing and performing rhythmic patterns (ta) (ti-ti) (tika-ti) (ti-tika)(tikatika)
- Playing untuned and tuned percussion instruments e.g., xylophones, bucket drums, chime bars and desk Bells
- Designing and making junkyard percussion instruments for performance and simple music compositions
- Learning to sing a song with some Aboriginal language (Yawuru) to perform at the end of term assembly in week 10 as part of the Indigenous Literacy Project, Busking for change
