New reception families will have until *C.O.B. Monday, 23rd November (Week 7)* to finalise their 2021 Booking Forms.

<u>Vacation Care:</u> The Program will be available from *Monday, 16th November at <u>10am</u> (Week 6)*. Bookings will open at this time, and can be made through the 'Xplor Home' app. *Bookings will close on Monday, 30th November at <u>6pm</u> (Week 8).*

The Governing Council has approved a <u>Non-</u><u>Notification Penalty</u> after a review of the procedures related to children's arrival at OSHC. We have decided to make these changes to ensure the safety of all children and to help rostering educators, so that we have adequate staffing each day.

As of the 1st of January 2021, a **Non-Notification Penalty** will be issued after a process of three reminders, which will then result in the suspension of care.
